Dr Elizabeth da Silva trained in Clinical Immunology and Immunopathology at the Royal Melbourne Hospital and the Canberra Hospital, becoming a dual fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians and the Royal College of Pathologists Australasia.

She was a Canberra Hospital/Australian National University fellow in 2013 and 2014. As a Visiting Medical Officer (VMO), Dr da Silva conducted a busy private clinic at National Capital Private Hospital and was a staff specialist at Canberra Hospital.

From 2018, Dr da Silva worked as an immunopathologist at ACT Pathology. She now continues to work as an immunopathologist with 4cyte Pathology part time.

Dr da Silva accepts referrals for adults children over the age of 12 years regarding a range of allergic conditions, and non-allergic problems of the immune system including chronic spontaneous urticaria, angioedema (including hereditary angioedema), systemic mastocytosis, sarcoidosis, immunodeficiency (including problems with recurrent serious infections or low immunoglobulin levels of uncertain cause), and recurrent fever syndromes.
