She was the Canberra Hospital/Australian National University Fellow in 2013–2014.

Dr da Silva accepts adult referrals for a wide range of allergic and immune conditions, including chronic spontaneous urticaria, angioedema (including hereditary angioedema), systemic mastocytosis, sarcoidosis, immunodeficiency (such as recurrent serious infections or unexplained low immunoglobulin levels), and recurrent fever syndromes. She also accepts referrals for children aged 12 and over for allergic conditions, including food allergies and hay fever.

Please note that Dr da Silva does not treat Mast Cell Activation Syndrome (MCAS), does not accept referrals for autoimmune diseases or COVID-19 vaccine exemptions, and consults Monday to Thursday.
